World News

Cambodia: Our partners M'Lup Russey tell us "Children who turn into adults in RCIs (orphanages) and leave as young adults (Care Leavers) are one of the most vulnerable groups in society and are highly disadvantaged in comparison to their peers" Pray for the M'Lup Russey team as they come alongside care leavers to help them adjust to life in the community.

Ethiopia: The aftermath of an extended drought continues to affect more than 24 million people in Ethiopia, and it is estimated that over 10 million will need food assistance this year. Please pray that people impacted most by the drought will have their urgent needs met. Ask God to bless the training where people are learning new agricultural skills and build resilience in difficult times. Lift up Tearfund Ireland and our church partners as they support communities hit hardest by the effects of climate change.

Refugees and displaced people: Join us in praying for all those who have been forced to flee their homes because of conflict, lack of food or broken economies. Grant them safe passage to a place of welcome. We pray that global leaders will develop wise, just and creative solutions for the migrant and refugee crises around the world.

CHS: We have begun the assessment of our programme work using the CHS Alliance, Core Humanitarian Standards process. The aim is to learn from the results to improve our work and to serve people better. Please continue to pray for our partners, programme participants and team members as we undertake this comprehensive and detailed assessment.
