- A strong level of theological understanding, particularly around integral mission – or an aptitude to learn
- A willingness to engage in training and development (at least 1 training day per year)
- Commitment to speak at least twice a year, and visit another speaker once a year
- Available to speak on Sundays and possibly other times

What will I do?

- You will speak (at least) 2 times a year
- Arrange some of your own speaking engagements
- Be willing to make a clear call to action at the end of each talk – inviting people to invest through finance and prayer into the Tearfund Ireland vision
- Get to communicate the great stories of what the local church is doing around the world
- Speak with passion about the work of Tearfund Ireland and its partners
- Go and hear another Tearfund Ireland speaker to learn from others and also provide constructive feedback

- Provide you with up to date resources and stories about Tearfund Ireland's work
- Provide you with useful feedback after your talks
