WORLD NEWS

- Please pray for South Sudan. More than six months ago a peace agreement was signed, but the humanitarian situation remains severe and there has been a continuation of conflict in some areas. Please ask God to heal divides and bring peace to this long-suffering nation.
- •Weeks of torrential rain has caused flooding in northern Syria. Pray for all who are affected, especially people living in temporary shelter displaced from their homes by conflict who urgently need shelter, food and health care. Ask that help would reach people in greatest need, as flooded roads are restricting access.
- •More than 5,000 cases of cholera have been confirmed so far in the aftermath of Cyclone Idai. Please pray for this outbreak to be contained. And please continue to pray for those who have lost loved ones, homes and businesses in the disaster.
- •Most people across Ethiopia and Uganda depend on growing crops to eat. Climate changes have disrupted normal weather patterns and people have to cope with extended periods of drought, or storms and floods which destroy crops. Please pray for the rains to come at the right time, and with no flooding. Please also pray for people as they learn new farming techniques to cope with drought and the risk of floods.
