## WORLD NEWS

- Ethiopia: Please pray for the Tearfund Ireland Ethiopia team and our partners there. The country has recently been in the news due to unrest and uncertainty. Unstable weather is also having a huge impact on people. Pray that the self-help groups can continue to meet and that essential travel will still be possible.
- South Sudan: famine was last declared there in 2017, with conflict a major cause. Latest reports say that 6.96 million people (61% of the population) are now in urgent need of help again. Please pray for peace in South Sudan and for the people in areas facing the worst shortages of food.
- Pray for an end to the Ebola outbreak, that has
  now spread from DRC to Uganda.
- In recent days the UN announced that there are now a record 70.8 million refugees in the world who have had to flee their homes because or war, persecution or violence. Please continue to pray for protection and hope for refugees as they seek new life and a way out of their situation.
