• Pray for all those impacted by the Coronavirus that is spreading and causing so much fear, isolation, illness and loss. Ask God to halt the spread of the virus and limit the suffering. Ask him to give leadership and medical experts discernment and guide their actions and strategies. Pray for God's encouragement for all the medical teams across the world who are serving the sick so sacrificially.

• Please pray for Zimbabwe, where people are struggling to feed their families in the midst of a huge drought. Although in some parts of the country it has finally begun to rain, the damage has already been done. Women's World Day of Prayer takes place on March 1st with a service written by the women of Zimbabwe to be broadcast on RTÉ 1 television and radio at 11am. • In Ethiopia locusts have been causing huge damage to crops. Please pray for Tearfund Ireland partners and SHGs in the Hawassa area, where farmers are concerned that their coffee and grain crops might be affected. Please pray for the security situation there in the lead up to elections in the summer. Pray for peace and stability.

• International Women's Day takes place on March 8th. Take time this month to pray that women everywhere may live the abundant life God intends for them.

• As the EU project that we are part of gets underway, please pray for favour as we communicate both the message and process of Alternative Care for orphaned and vulnerable children. Pray that it will result in more children growing up in a family based care setting instead of an institution.

• Continue to pray for those recently elected into Irish parliament, that they will quickly form a new government which will have an appropriately, positive approach to overseas development aid.
