## WORLD NEWS

• Ethiopia: In Ethiopia our partners are responding to the impact of both locust swarms and coronavirus simultaneously, please pray that they will be able to find solutions and protect the most vulnerable. Please continue to pray that the impact of Coronavirus will be lessened in poorer countries.

• We are hearing from peers working to keep children in families that children living in orphanages are being sent back to their families because of Covid-19. Please pray that vulnerable children will be kept safe and that supports will be available to families to keep their children out of institutions in the future. Pray for the M'Lup Russey team in Cambodia as they raise awareness, distribute emergency food and hygiene supplies and provide support to care-leavers, foster families and vulnerable children at this time.

• Pray for Yemen which reported its first coronavirus case in April. The country is facing a humanitarian crisis with 24 million people struggling to survive without access to clean water or safe sanitation. This will prove even more deadly if the virus spreads. Pray for peace and unity from leaders so the virus can be contained.
