Ask God to give wisdom and guidance to Ethiopia's leaders as they face challenges on many fronts.
- Lebanon: Please continue to pray for the people of Beirut following the recent explosion as the psychological impact of the disaster becomes more evident, with many experiencing mental health difficulties.
   Please pray for an end to conflict in the region, and for God to comfort all those who have lost their homes and loved ones.
- The Global Church Pledge on behalf of vulnerable children: In 2019, a group representing faith-based organisations gathered together in New York during the United Nations General Assembly to discuss how we can together accelerate our efforts to see Christians supporting children in safe, loving families around the world.
