Tearfund Ireland are sending humanitarian assistance to Somaliland and Yemen and continue to support those affected by the conflict in northern Ethiopia. Please pray for rain, for stabilisation of weather patterns and for this season's crops not to fail. Pray, also resilience as families wait to see what their next harvest will produce.
- As we face into a number of challenging circumstances around the world, we pray for continued provision to demonstrate the goodness of God. We pray for opportunities to declare hope where there is despair, peace where there is chaos and love where there is anger.
