Ethiopia: Please pray for our Ethiopian partners as they are wrapping up project activities for this year and preparing a report on the last 12 months of activities. Please pray for a smooth start to the next phase of the project this month (September).

We hope to be welcoming a new member of staff to our team in Ethiopia. This person will bring skills to help us strengthen our ability to evaluate our projects toward even better outcomes for those who participate in the Self Help Groups. Please pray for the team as they welcome their new colleague.

Lebanon: Continue to pray for Lebanon as it is in its fourth year of deep economic, political and social crisis. In June 2023, Lebanon recorded the second highest food price inflation in the world, which has had a devastating impact on the food security of both Lebanese and Syrian households. Pray for safety in travel and for strengthening of relationships as we look forward to working together into the future.
