Give thanks that our partners in Cambodia were invited to contribute to a devotional for orphan Sunday in November reflecting on the joy that children bring and challenging us to protect that joy.

## World News

**Cambodia:** Our partners in Cambodia have been very busy with an external evaluation of their programme work this autumn. They have also been updating their strategy for the next two years. Please pray for rest for the team over the Christmas period and a refreshed start in 2025

**Ethiopia:** We have submitted our proposal for funding from Irish Aid for the next few years. Please join us in praying that the application is read with favour and that we will be successful.

**Lebanon:** Thank God for the ceasefire announced in late November. Pray for safety as people return to their homes in affected areas. There may be some people who will be unable to return to their homes in the short term, pray for them, particularly as the colder winter weather begins. Pray that peace will last and that our partners will get some rest and refreshment with their families over the Christmas period. Please continue to pray for peace to come across the wider region.

## Ireland
